The City of Dallas is soliciting competitive sealed bids from qualified contractors for services to remove existing and install new HVAC equipment within the civic center building as these services are being funded by City of Dallas local funds. Bids should be typed or submitted in ink and returned in a sealed container marked on the outside with the Bid Number and Company Name. Bids will be received until 11:00am on June 26, 2025 at the City of Dallas Public Works, 320 E. Foster Ave. Dallas, Georgia 30132, at which time the bids will be publicly opened read aloud. Bids received after the above date and time, or in any location other than Dallas Public Works, will not be considered.

Questions regarding bids should be directed to Brandon Rakestraw, Public Works Director, at brakestraw@dallas-ga.gov or by calling 770-443-8110, no later than June 23, 2025. Bids are legal and binding upon the bidder when submitted. All bids should be submitted in duplicate.

The written bid documents supersede any prior verbal or written communications between the parties.

An award will be made to the contractor submitting the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The City of Dallas reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive technicalities, and to make an award deemed in its best interest. Bids may be split or awarded in entirety. Dallas reserves the option to negotiate terms, conditions and pricing with the lowest responsive, responsible bidder(s) at its discretion.

Award notification will be posted after award on the city website, <u>www.dallasga.gov</u> and companies submitting a bid will be notified via e-mail.

# **SCOPE OF WORK**

Bidder shall furnish all labor, equipment, and materials to perform the services as described below.

#### Scope of Work:

Replacement of two (2) existing 2-ton minisplit systems with one (1) new 2-ton minisplit system and one (1) new 3-ton wall mount minisplit system, including all associated labor and materials needed to ensure proper installation, start-up, and operation.

#### **Project Description:**

#### • Equipment Replacement:

- Remove the two (2) existing 2-ton minisplit systems (indoor and outdoor components).
- Supply and install one (1) new 2-ton split system (condenser and air handler) and one (1) new 3-ton wall mount minisplit system (condenser and air handler).

#### • Piping and Wiring:

- Install new refrigerant piping between indoor and outdoor units, sized and routed per manufacturer specifications and industry standards.
- Install new condensate piping with proper slope and termination for drainage.
- Install new control wiring between indoor and outdoor units, including communication/control circuits as required.

#### • Thermostat Installation:

• Supply and install a new, compatible thermostat for full functionality and ease of use.

#### • Air Distribution Components:

- Install one (1) return filter rack for accessible filter replacement and improved indoor air quality for 2-ton minisplit system.
- Fabricate and install new supply plenum for 2-ton minisplit system.
- Supply and install two (2) supply grilles, properly sized and located for even airflow distribution for 2-ton minisplit system.

#### • Crane Service:

Provide crane service to safely remove the existing outdoor unit and place the new condenser in its designated location.

#### • Installation:

- All work shall be completed in accordance with state and local codes.
- All work shall be completed per manufacturer recommendations and specifications.
- All refrigerant lines shall be pressure tested and vacuumed before charging to ensure system integrity.
- A startup and testing of the system shall be conducted to verify full functionality.

#### **Clarifications/Exclusions:**

• Work shall be completed during normal business hours (8:00am – 5:00pm M-F).

#### TIME OF COMPLETION AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

Bidder must agree to commence work on or before a date to be specified in a written "Notice to Proceed" by the Owner and substantially complete the project within **Twenty (20)** consecutive calendar days thereafter. The time allowed for final completion and readiness for final payment is Thirty (30) days from the date of Notice to Proceed. Bidders must also agree to pay, as liquidated damages, the sum of \$50.00 per each consecutive calendar day thereafter based on the time for the substantial completion for the work.
