The city reserves the right to reject any or all Statements of Qualifications or Technical Approach, and to waive technicalities and informalities at the discretion of the city. All submittals must be delivered to City of Dallas, City Hall, Attn: Brandon Rakestraw, Public Works Director, 129 East Memorial Drive; Dallas, Georgia 30132 by the deadline date and time. A representative of the City of Dallas will publicly read the names of the companies submitting qualifications at **2:00 p.m. on October 7, 2025**. Any submittals received after the deadline date and time will be returned unopened. Incomplete submittals may not be considered if the omissions are determined to be significant. The Submittal must follow the format and meet the content requirements identified in **Section VI**, entitled **Instructions for Content and Preparation of Statements of Qualifications – Phase I Response**. See **Attachment 1** for a summary of how the submittals should be prepared.
